MINUTES OF THE MEETING WITH THE STATES HELD ON 31.10.2013 AT NIRMAN BHAVAN, NEW DELHI REGARDING IMPLEMENTATION OF INTEGRATED WATERSHED MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME (IWMP) PROJECTS ON THE PATTERN OF WORLD BANK ASSISTED WATERSHED MANAGEMENT PROJECT 'NEERANCHAL'

The meeting on implementation of Integrated Watershed Management Programme (IWMP) projects, on the pattern of World Bank assisted Watershed Management Project 'Neeranchal', in one district in each States (Uttar Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Haryana, Nagaland, Tripura, Himachal Pradesh, West Bengal, Bihar, Assam and Kerala) was held on 31st October, 2013 under the chairmanship of the Secretary (LR) in the Committee Room of the Department of Land Resources (DoLR) at NBO Building, Nirman Bhavan, New Delhi.

Joint secretary (WM & Neeranchal), Department of Land Resources welcomed the participants. In his opening remarks Secretary (LR) stated that the Watershed Programme is the future of India in terms of food security, water security and biodiversity conservation. He stated that the States should have a clear plan regarding institutional arrangements and capacity building plans along with the details of institutions involved, subject of training, duration and frequency of the programme for success of the programme.

JS (WM & Neeranchal) made a presentation on the Integrated Watershed Management Programme (IWMP). He emphasized on the involvement of NGO for awareness, social mobilization, training, institution building and evaluations. He further advised the States that the contract with the NGOs to be on performance basis payment.

He stated that the DoLR proposes to implement World Bank assisted Watershed Management Programme 'Neeranchal' in 8 States with the objective of improving the efficiency of the ongoing Integrated Watershed Management Program (IWMP). The learning's and innovations of 'Neeranchal' may also be replicated in the 10 Non-Neeranchal States i.e. Uttar Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Haryana, Nagaland, Tripura, Himachal Pradesh, West Bengal, Bihar, Assam and Kerala.

He proposed to implement IWMP projects in one district each in the above Non-Neeranchal States on the pattern of 'Neeranchal'. At the Central level DoLR will coordinate the activities in 'Neeranchal' and Non-Neeranchal States simultaneously; so that both the innovations will deliver the desired results and the systems in place will benefit the programme in the whole State. Accordingly, he requested the States representatives to identify one district each in their State for the implementation of IWMP on the pattern of 'Neeranchal'.

After detailed deliberations, States representatives identified one district each in their States for implementation of IWMP projects on the pattern of World Bank assisted Watershed Management Project 'Neeranchal' as detailed under:
