## ORDER

As per the letter read as first paper above, Government of India have released an amount of ₹ 446.00 lakh (General Category), ₹ 46.00 lakh (SCP Category) and ₹ 8.00 lakh (TSP Category) towards first installment of funds under Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana: Other interventions for implementing water conservation and water harvesting works during 2015-16.

- 2. As per the order read as second paper above, Government have released an amount of ₹ 446.00 lakh (Rupees Four hundred and forty six lakh only) to the Commissioner of Rural Development towards the Central share of General category of PMKSY.
- 3. The Commissioner of Rural Development, as per the letter read as third paper above has furnished re-appropriation proposals reducing the provision under the Central share of the general component of the scheme for the release of corresponding state share and that of SCP and TSP Components.
- 4. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to release the following amount towards the balance of first installment of funds to the Commissioner of Rural Development under Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana: Other interventions for implementing water conservation and water harvesting works during 2015-16.

The release of fund is subject to the following conditions:-

- i. The priority should be given to Blocks where IWMP projects are in terminal/works phase of implementation. In case of Blocks where IWMP projects are not under implementation, the SLNA shall plan and execute activities pertaining to rain water harvesting and ground water recharge on watershed basis.
- ii. The Implementing Agency should adhere to the cost norms and pattern of assistance and other procedures as prescribed in the PMKSY guidelines issued by the Department of Agriculture, Cooperation and Farmers Welfare and common guidelines for Watershed Programme issued by the Department of Land Resources.
- iii. Monthly progress report and cumulative monthly physical and financial progress reports indicating its unit cost norms, targets and corresponding achievements under various components is to be sent to the Department of Agriculture, Cooperation and Farmers Welfare
- iv. The State Government will be required to utilize the funds in the current financial year for implementation of the scheme and also furnish utilization certificates in the prescribed proforma.

- v. State Implementing Authority shall maintain subsidiary accounts of Grant-in-aid received and get the accounts audited relating to released funds from a Chartered Accountant and furnish a copy each of the Audit Report, Audited Statement of Accounts, balance sheet, receipt and payment account and income and expenditure statement to Department of Agriculture, Cooperation and Farmers Welfare as early as possible.
- vi. The fund should be utilized as per the guidelines of PMKSY and Watershed guidelines during 2015-16. There should not be any duplication or overlapping of activities/areas covered under PMKSY vis-à-vis existing schemes of Central or State Government.
- vii. The accounts of the State Grantee Institution shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act, 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department wherever the State(s)/institution is called upon to do so.
- viii. Audited records of all assets, permanent or semi-permanent acquired wholly or substantially out of the grant sanctioned to the Implementing Agency should be maintained as prescribed in form GFR-19A and shall be furnished to Government annually by the end of June, following the financial year to which it relates. Such assets shall not, without prior approval of the Government of India be disposed of, encumbered or utilized for the purpose other than those for which the grant is made.
- ix. Implementing Agency should identify SC/ST beneficiaries among the total beneficiaries to achieve prescribed targets and book the amount of grant in-aid released for SCs/STs under the relevant Head of Accounts. Implementing Agency should invariably report the same on monthly basis.
